Clinical Fellowship in Regional Anesthesia & Acute Pain Medicine (AORA Accredited)

Salient Features for Applicants:

The Clinical Fellowship in Regional Anesthesia & Acute Pain Medicine is a full-time, in-house, one-year post-doctoral academic program. The fellowship will run from January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2025.

Eligibility:

Applicants must hold an MD or DNB in Anesthesia, or a DA with at least one year of relevant experience.

Curriculum Focus:

- The fellowship emphasizes Regional Anesthesia and Acute Interventional Pain Medicine, including:
- Central Neuraxial blocks
- ▶ Plexus and Peripheral Nerve Blocks
- Techniques using conventional methods, Peripheral Nerve Stimulators (PNS), and ultrasound guidance
- Perineural catheters for continuous infusions
- A structured, disciplined approach to academics will be followed, including weekly seminars and guest lectures.

Academic and Clinical Responsibilities:

The curriculum, centered on Regional Anesthesia and Acute Pain, emphasizes building dexterity and expertise in wide array of ultrasound-guided neural and interfascial interventions.

Along with, candidates will take on the clinical responsibilities of a Senior Registrar, receive a stipend, and adhere to AORA executive guidelines.
